

WASTE MANAGEMENT

INFECTIOUS WASTE

- Items contaminated with Blood and Body fluids (Dialysis Set, Folye's Bag, NG Tube, Drain, Dressing, Swab Bandage, Surgical Drapes, IV set etc.)
- PPE Visibly soaked with blood, secretions or body fluid of patient (Cap, Mask, Gown, Gloves etc.)
- Waste in contact with patients infected with highly infectious disease

Note: Don't throw Highly Pressurized Containers, Plastic Bottles, Air Freshener, Insect Killer, Cold Drink Cans

Infectious Waste Storage

- Infectious Waste is contained in double Yellow Waste Bag with Biohazard Bag
- Waste Bag to be sealed with cable tie after 2/3rd (75%) filled
- Sharps are contained in Puncture proof sharp box with biohazard symbol

Infectious Waste Treatment & Disposal

- Sealed Yellow Waste bags shall be collected by SIHT Staff (after each visit) for transportation to Incinerator for treatment and ultimate disposal

GENERAL WASTE

- Discarded Items such as empty containers, tissues, wrappers, covering, cardboard etc.
- Empty Packing and Bottles
- Items not soaked or spotted with blood or body fluid
- Highly Pressurized Containers, Plastic Bottles, Air Freshener, Insect Killer, Cold Drink Cans

General Waste Storage

- General Waste is contained in Blue Waste Bag

General Waste Disposal

- Responsibility of collection and disposal is with the patient's family
- General waste may be disposed of with household garbage.



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
